# About Eskişehir

Eskişehir (pronounced [es'kiʃehir]; Turkish: eski "old", şehir "city")) is a city in northwestern Turkey and the capital of the Eskişehir Province. According to the 2011 census, the population of the city is 648,396. The city is located on the banks of the Porsuk River, 792 m above sea level, where it overlooks the fertile Phrygian Valley. In the nearby hills one can find hot springs. The city is 233 km (145 mi) to the west of Ankara, 330 km (205 mi) to the southeast of Istanbul and 78 km (48 mi) to the northeast of Kütahya. Known as a university town, both Eskişehir Osmangazi University and Anadolu University (which has one of the largest student enrollments in the world) are based in Eskişehir. The province covers an area of 2,678 km<sup>2</sup> (1,034 sq mi).

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# How to Reach Eskişehir



- It is on mid-west Anatolia.
- By bus or fast train it is about 5 hours from Istanbul & 2,5 hours from Ankara.
- Istanbul is recommended as a transfer location since there is a direct metro line from Ataturk Airport to the Bus Station and fast train line is very close to Sabiha Gökçen Airport. However, Ankara is also a convenient since there is a direct transportation to Bus & Train stations.

# Further Details & Selection: O'Captain my Captain

- The training course will take place in Eskişehir, Turkey between *26th of April and 2nd of May*. The arrivals and first meeting will be on *25th*.
- The Project Includes 11 Countries: Croatia, Czech Republic, Estonia, Germany, Hungary, Italy, Macedonia, Romania, Slovakia, Spain, Turkey.
- There will be 2 participants selected from each country.
- Main priorities for the selection are: Reason of applying, motivation, past experience in related field, learning goals and dissemination goals.
- Gender balance will also be one of the priorities of the selection.

- Accomodation: We will cover the nights from 25th of April to 1st May.
- Programme: Will start on 25th evening and end on 2nd Afternoon.
- Venue: All the TC will take place at the same location.
- Food & Coffee Breaks: We will cover 3 meals & 2 coffee breaks per day.
- Transportation: The expenses for transportation will be covered according to the project budget for each country.(Details Below)
- Reimbursement: The reimbursements will be done after we receive all documents of transportation: Flight/Bus/Train/Metro tickets & receipts.

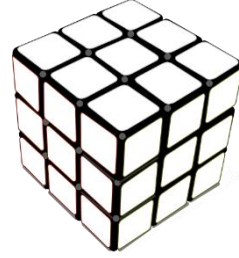
