Project Information

This Training Course is defined to improve youth workers' skills about the idea expression as to be active citizens, applying also a digital citizenship, in order to improve their methods for sharing information with youngsters, thus to help them understand how to be active citizens and to express themselves through new media use, social media, citizenship, street actions, flash mobs and the tools related to the active citizenship and communication, ideas expression.

Youth workers will participate in a preparation of a social campaign about citizenship to be shared in all countries involved, made by video and with new media use, but also they will prepare an event in Zonguldak, Turkey, a final exhibition, a street event to share the results of the project.

The Training Course involves fourteen countries: Turkey, Bulgaria, Denmark, Croatia, Italy, Hungary, Poland, Slovakia, Romania, Greece, Estonia, Lithuania, Macedonia and Slovenia.

The main topics are:

- definition of citizenship and EU citizenship;
- citizenship use and tools;
- promotion of correct use of new media;
- dissemination of tools about new technologies issues;
- citizenship and new media, how to combine them;
- preparation of a social campaign about citizenship.

The main objectives are:

- to create or develop new communication channels and platforms (such as: Facebook, Youtube, Twitter), where use citizenship tools;
- to raise awareness on the social issues relevant to the work of participants among them and their target groups;
- to stimulate the sense of entrepreneurship and responsibility for their work among participants;
- to create a link between professional business and social work by showing that skills relevant to work and career can be used and developed also in youth work, making the said person more attractive on a labour market.

Participants Profile & Language and Tasks

Age: No limits

Language: will be English, it is useful at least a basic knowledge about the language.

Every country will send 2 participants.

Tasks: bring informations (to be presented during the training) about the citizenship rights in your country and the new media use and dissemination)

Information About City

Zonguldak is a city and the capital of Zonguldak Province in the Black Sea region of Turkey. Its population, according to the 2009 census, was 108,792. It is an important port on the Black Sea because of the coal mining in Zonguldak Province. Zonguldak has an oceanic climate high and evenly distributed rainfall the year round. Summers are warm and humid, and the average temperature is around 20°C in October. Winters are cool and damp, and the average temperature is around 10°C in March.

Visa Requirements

Turkey is not yet in the EU so please bring along your passports! Some of you may need visa. You can get visa in airport. Please check the board before the passport control if you need visa or not. **It costs 20 USD (18 EUR) if you buy from e-Visa and if you buy in the border, it costs 25 EUR.**

Please check your passports that your arrival date is 6 months before your passport expiry date!

Visa cost will be reimbursed %100 when it is presented.

For visa, you do not need apply for a visa and you can obtain in the border or from the website of the Turkish Foreign Ministry.

! Note: Reimbursement of travel costs will only be done upon presentation of all (including return tickets) original tickets, receipt/invoices and boarding passes. Please remember to bring the original invoices – there will be no reimbursement without the original invoices and tickets with indicated Names of travellers, description of the journey, indication of cost and currency and date of travel.

Please do not lose your boarding passes; you will need them for reimbursement of travel cost.

This will be very helpful to organisers to begin processing the financial and reimbursement data so that all payments may be made as efficiently as possible.
