



“TAKE A RISK”

TRAINING COURSE PROJECT

**4 – 12 April 2017
Marmaris / TURKEY**

SUMMARY

TAKE A RISK is a project, which involves youth worker mobility, will be carried out in Marmaris/Mugla-Turkey at 4 - 12 April 2017. In this training course which 12 countries will be attended in, contains entrepreneurship, career management, youth unemployment, labor market and non-formal education subjects.

2 youth workers from each group of Bosnia and Herzegovina, Hungary, Slovakia, Armenia, Belarus, Bulgaria, Croatia, Czechia, Latvia, Lithuania, Spain and Turkey will be attended in this project. In this training, there will be totally 24 participants and there will be 3 trainers and 3 supporting staff, which take in charge.

This project aims that supporting the youth entrepreneurship and contributing youth to make right decisions while they are in process of taking risks. With this aim, in these sessions, which are organized with non-formal methods, there will be experiential learning and outdoor activities in.

With this training course, we are planning help youth to make right decisions while they are in process of taking risks and increase their ability to entrepreneurship. Starting a business by their own and contributing the employment are one of the aims of this project. In this direction, we expected to decrease youth unemployment with contributing to generalize entrepreneurship works.

OUTDOOR EDUCATION

Outdoor education is the use of experiences in the outdoors for the education and development of a person. It is not only “learning outside the classroom”. But also learning from the challenges and adventures that we are facing. During the training course, we will go on a 1-2 days hike in a forest (might be 1 day hiking 1 day trekking). We will be camping, preparing food on a fire, sleeping in a self made tents. So it is important to prepare your self for this adventure. For that you will need:

- a backpack
- a sleeping bag
- sleeping mattress / sleeping pad (please inform us if you don't have any sleeping mattress, you can buy here as well)
- comfortable footwear (2 pairs, in case one is damaged or you get tired)
- 2 long trousers (avoid shorts as there might be mosquitos)
- headwear (cap)
- a jacket/sweater
- 2 t-shirts (consider long sleeves as it might protect you from mosquitos)
- underwear and socks
- swimming suite
- towel
- eating tools (pocket knife, spoon, fork)
- dishes (bowl, cup; preferably plastic ones as we will need to carry everything)
- your medicines (if you need anything, or you are allergic to something, e.g. bees)
- repellents: agains mosquitos, ticks
- flashlight
- rain coat (might be useful)
- compass (if you have one)

Age limit for participants: 18 – 40 (**exceptional ages:** over 40)

NOTE: Each group should has minimum 1 disadvantaged participant as economically or culturally (cultural differences)

PROJECT PLACE

Marmaris is a port town and tourist resort on the Mediterranean coast, located in Muğla Province, southwest Turkey, along the shoreline of the Turkish Riviera.

Marmaris' main source of income is tourism. It has an exceptional location between two intersecting sets of mountains by the sea, though following a construction boom in the 1980s, little is left of the sleepy fishing village that Marmaris was until the late 20th century. In 2010 the town's population was 30,957 and peaks at around 300,000 to 400,000 people during the tourist season.

It is also a centre for sailing and diving, possessing two major and several smaller marinas. It is a popular wintering location for hundreds of cruising boaters, being also served by the nearby Dalaman Airport.

PREPARATION

- Please try to create the team as **1 male + 1 female** for gender balance of the project.
- If you have any special health condition or special dietary requirements, please inform us before the project.
- We will organize NGO Fair session. If you have, please bring materials about your organization.
- Preparation of the intercultural evening: You will have to prepare a creative presentation of your country for the intercultural night (5 minutes) but the challenge is to use NO videos and NO Powerpoint presentations. Instead, we would like you to tell us myths & legends about your country and to bring additional drinks/snacks from your country to share with the whole group (about 25 -30 people)
- Collect examples of funding opportunities in your country to support young entrepreneurs
- Collect examples of good practices on youth entrepreneurship projects in your country
- Collect examples of social entrepreneurship examples and find sources and read about (start up, social entrepreneurship, developing a business plan, social hubs, incubators) and share these sources on facebook group
- Prepare a caps for yourself and share it on facebook group :)
- Please make sure that all participants have insurance. Insurances will be under the participants' responsibility.

INSURANCE

Outdoor Entrepreneurs will not contract any insurance for the group. As explained in the application form already, obtaining a health and a full travel insurance are at your own responsibility . If you still haven't got any insurance, I highly recommend you to order insurance since we will have outdoor activities in the nature.

VISA

- **If you need visa**, you can buy the visa which is around 15€ - 25€ at the arrived airport in Turkey. But we suggest that you apply the e-visa with the link below.

INFORMATION and CONDITIONS

- Please don't forget to bring
 - Traditional drinks/snacks from your country as well as traditional legends or myths/songs/dances/games to share with everyone during the intercultural evening - presentation materials of your organization.
 - Presentation of the situation of youth entrepreneurship in your country
 - Preferably casual clothes
- Weather conditions in April: **25.9 °C** (Average high) and **15.8 °C** (Average low °C)
Generally, it is sunny. Sometimes, it can be rainy.
- Turkish Lira (TRY) is valid in Turkey. **1 € = 3,55 TL** (it is changeable)
- You have to buy return trip tickets for all transportations from your home to the hotel. Taxi, gas invoice ext. aren't available. You have to keep tickets, invoices and visa stickers ext. and give all of them to the host organization in the project. You can see the travel limits below.

NOTE: Hotel information will share with you soon.

- If Turkish National Agency transfer us the money before the project, ticket and visa reimbursements will be in the project. If not, we will transfer the money to your account in 1 week after Turkish National Agency transfers us the project budget.
- Accommodation, foods and coffee breaks will be provided by project.
- All participants have to arrive **Dalaman Airport**.
- You can see the link of bus shuttles from Dalaman airport to Marmaris below. You can see the buses in front of Domestic Terminal. There are 2 companies. Company1 is **MUTTAS** and Company2 is **HAVAS**. You will need Turkish Lira for payment in the bus. Prices for both of company are same. It is 15,00 TL for now.
